Mr. Frank Johnson Jr., MSgt, USAF, Retired was born August 19, 1961 in Birmingham Alabama to Mrs. Amelia T. Smith and Frank Johnson Sr., whom both preceded him in death. Frank was the only child. Reverend George L. Smith (step father) and sister Brittany Jones also preceded him in death. Frank relocated to Battle Creek, Michigan in 1968.

Frank received his education through the Springfield education system. Frank also received an Associate Degree in Arts from Soumi College (Finlandia University) in 1981, an Associate Degree in Allied Health Science through the United States Force in 1984, a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration from Regence College (Excelsior) in 1994 and a Master's Degree in Science Administration from Central Michigan University in 2002.

Frank joined the United States Air Force in November 1982 and after 20 years; he retired as a Master Sergeant. Frank continued his commitment to Civil Service, as a Health Insurance Specialist with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Service, from 2005 until 2024.

Frank confessed Christ at an early age and was baptized at Shiloh Baptist Church under the late Pastor Taylor. Frank is currently a member at Maryland City Baptist Church, Laurel Maryland, where he is an Usher and serves on the Trustees Committee.

Frank leaves his legacy to be cherished by his devoted wife, Enilda, daughters, Leilani and Jasmine Johnson of Laurel, Maryland, grand-pup Bentley, and a sister Ashley Jones of Battle Creek, Michigan. He also leaves 3 aunts, an uncle, 2 brother in-laws, 3 sister in-laws, numerous cousins, nieces, nephews and friends.
