Robert was educated in the West Virginia Public School System where he graduated from Theodore Roosevelt High School in 1973. After graduating from high school, Robert enlisted into the United States Army where he served for 7 years and he was Honorably Discharged. During his enlistment, he studied to become a Physician's Assistant, which would become his life long career. Robert continued his education and received his Bachelor of Science Degree from Howard University.

Robert "Bob" as he affectionately known by many colleagues, was an excellent health care provider and passionate about his patients, colleagues and everyone that he came in contact with. H enjoyed watching them run around and tiring themselves out so that they could get ice cream afterwards.
