He always met me whenever he visited Delhi. I was invited to IIT Kanpur in 2008 to speak on "Entrepreneurs Build the Nation" as part of some students festival. They requested me for a speaker for an event and I suggested Tito Singh and he came all the way from US with his wife Laurie, a very decent lady. So we spent almost three days together at IIT Kanpur. “*Tejinder was very proud of his background and the institution IIT Khadagpur in India where he studied. After having worked with International media platforms, he launched his own newspaper India America Today catering to Indian diaspora with. He was a rare breed of journalists extremely talented, simple, non conformists and always asking tough questions to the authorities. He would never compromise with professional ethics and hence struggled to survive the financial rigours to run a newspapers. Despite all challenges, he would never leave hope to make his dream project a true success. He was not a marketer for sure. He said I can't be two, I am hard core journalist and Good Journalism will find its way one day. He would discuss things, situation in India and US. He wanted to launch a Hindi edition, had already started Panjabi edition and would be instantly ready for any new idea. He was reading this book last month about the media mistakes pollute the world, and would keep me update about anything exciting he would come across. Just a few days before his departure from this physical world he had shared pictures of a Deer family who will visit him regularly and befriended him. A gentleman with a child like curiosity and knack for details, he is a great personal loss. I am geographically closer to his younger brother who he searched for years and finally found in Rajasthan, the state in India where I live. We have conveyed the message to his caretakers in old age home and enquired his well being also. Teji also spoke to him regularly and met him few years back. He was a pure soul who valued friends and his work. He would often miss his mother and had posted photos of her with himself. He would never fail to remind me that I have not to stop anytime, as best will happen sooner. He has given me all warmth and courage to continue to do good journalism and work despite all odds.
